As our letterhead indicates, many local Haitian base Nonprofits, such as the Haitian Heritage, the Haitian Methodist Church, and the CaliHaitian have joined to form a solid block to help an unexpected over-flood of refugee immigrants including Haitian, African, and Honduran coming to the United States from Central America and Brazil.

This Crisis dated back on May 2016, Immigration starts to release mass refugee seekers to the Haitian Methodist Church. To date, we have served over fifteen hundred (1500) refugees to resettle. However, according to our Source at the Homeland Security this number is expected to triple in the coming months. In fact, we are reaching out to bring more partners in order to facilitate them a better journey while keeping our community safe. Despite the collaboration of some of the local agencies, such as the Catholic Charities, the San Diego Alliance and the Casa Cornelia we are still in great needs for human services, Social assistance, and public support. Attached is a breakdown of current needs.

Thank you for being one of our valued supporters, we appreciate your cooperation in this matter. We look forward to continuing this journey with you.
