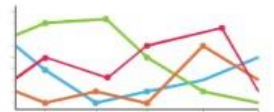

## Statistic



15.6% of San Diego residents are living in poverty - greater than national rate of 14.7% (2015)<sup>1</sup>

Almost 1 in 5 children (19.7%) are in poverty in San Diego and almost 2 in 5 are in economic hardship (38.2%) (2015)<sup>1</sup>

Nearly 1 in 3 families (32.2%) in single parent households are living below the poverty line<sup>1</sup>

More than six thousand children and youth have been served by homeless-dedicated services<sup>2</sup>

- 2,588 were served in emergency shelters, 1,303 in transitional housing, and 581 by street outreach

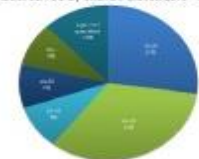
## Network of referring organizations that we service:

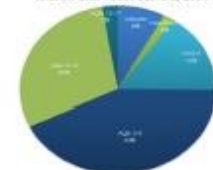
## Program Impact continue
