Job Summary

Quality Assurance = 4-6 people

- Clothing Processing oversees the sorting, and quality assurance of donations received
- Sort and inspect all donations
- Ensure quality guidelines are met (No rips, No stains, No dirty clothes,)
- Put clothing in appropriate boxes (Newborn, Child ,Youth , Adults Men/ Women, Homeless Men/ Women) Needs to be washed

Runners = 4- 6 people

- Take boxes of clothes from QA team to the Sorting Team
- Once the Sorting Team has Sort and Fold clothing by sizes
- Take clothing to the closet and restock clothing shelves and racks
- Once all clothing shelves and racks are well stoked (place overflow in storage boxes
- Label overflow in storage boxes by sizes
- Take trash to the dumpster

Clothing Sorters = 8 - 10 people

• Sort and Fold clothing by sizes (Newborn, Child , Youth , Adults)

Shoe Sorters

- Spray shoes with Lysol
- Sort shoes by sizes (Newborn, Child , Youth , Adults)
- Put size labels on shoes (rubber band pairs)
- Put shoes by size in storage boxes (example: women size 9)

Inventory Control

• Document what we are lacking

Baggers = 2- 4 people

- Pack 1 bag of clothing per request (referral) 10-12 items per bag depending on availability (example: 1 – pants 2 tops = 3 outfits)
- If more than 1 person listed on a referral form please complete 1 form per person additional forms are onsite
- Once completed packing the bag, staple the identification label to the bag

• If you have to contact client to get correct clothing size please do so

Referral Sorter = 1 person

• Sort Referrals by date order form oldest to most resent

Data Entry = 2 -3 people

• Enter Referral information in excel

Photographer = 1-2 people rotation

- Make sure a photo release is signed
- Capture the FACES and the moments of all volunteers hard at work
- Capture the environment (Signage, Tables, Work Areas)
- Take a Group photo
