- **Personal Styling:** Offer personal styling advice to individuals accessing our services.
- **Inventory Management:** Replenish stock items on shelves and maintain an organized display.
- **Program Support:** Assist with our flagship program, "Bags of Hope," serving vulnerable populations, including veterans, at-risk youth, and survivors of domestic abuse by providing essential clothing and hygiene products.
- **Resource Knowledge:** Maintain knowledge of resources, programs, and procedures to assist volunteers and staff.
- **Order Processing:** Process incoming referrals and emergency requests, generating and printing orders.
- **Emergency Fulfillment:** Fulfill emergency requests by creating and packing customized bags of clothing and accessories.
- Client and Volunteer Check-In: Assist with checking in/out clients, donors, and volunteers.
- **Store Maintenance:** Ensure a clean, organized, and safe environment to keep the store customer-ready.
- **Communication:** Communicate successes or potential barriers to the Executive Team.
- **Team Support:** Assist the Executive Team and program staff in achieving organizational goals with additional tasks as assigned.
- **Volunteer Tours and Training:** Provide tours for first-time volunteers and donors, and train new volunteers and groups.
